Conifers

3 year seedlings- bundle of 25- \$17

Colorado Blue Spruce (*Picea pungens*)

Slow grower, best on well-drained soils. Needles tint blue with age. Popular as a Christmas tree or an ornamental.

Douglas Fir (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)

Medium /fast grower, best on well-drained soils. Small soft needles make an excellent Christmas tree. Good for wildlife and windbreaks.

Norway Spruce (*Picea abies*)

Fastest growing of all spruces, best on well-drained sites. Noted for drooping branches, recommended for windbreaks, ornamental, wildlife, and Christmas trees.

Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*)

All soil conditions except poorly drained. Grows moderately fast. Uses: lumber production, windbreaks, & wildlife habitat.

Concolor Fir (*Abies concolor*)

Dense, narrow growth with domed crown. Needles citrus scented. Exists on poor dry sites, does best in moist, well-drained, acid soils. Rapid grower after established. Handsome ornamental or Christmas tree.

Hardwoods & Shrubs

All hardwoods/shrubs- bundle of 5 - \$6
Oak & Maple bundle of 25- \$20

Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*)

New Jersey's state tree! Best in sandy-rich

loam soil in full sun. Tolerant of salt and air pollution. Valuable for timber and wildlife.

Sugar maple (*Acer saccharum*)

This dual purpose tree provides excellent shade, and when mature produces sap used for maple syrup. Wood used in furniture making. Leaves turn orange/red in autumn.

Red Bud (*Cercis canadensis*)

Reddish/purple buds open to rosy pink in early spring. Grows to 20'-30' with equal spread. Effective in mass plantings.

Northern Bayberry (*Myrica pennsylvanica*)

Native shrub producing waxy berries used in candle making. Fragrant foliage. Grows to 8' tall in full sun and moist, sandy soil.

Wildflower Seeds

4 ounce poly-bags \$13 each

Sunny Mix- Full sun and drier conditions with a full spectrum of colors. Covers 1,350 sq. ft.

Shady Mix- Does well in dappled sun or partial shade. Covers 1,200 sq. ft.

Bird & Butterfly Mix- Attracts nectar loving birds & insects. Contains varieties that produce seed winter feeding birds appreciate. Covers 1,350 sq. ft.

Enviro-friendly Mix- Flowering herbs and wildflowers that attract beneficial insects. Contains varieties that help deter many garden pests. Covers 1,350 sq. ft.
